

ANNUAL AHERA NOTIFICATION

In accordance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's rule 763.84 this document serves as annual notice for the 2017-2018 school year that there are buildings on the campus of Tennessee School for the Deaf that contain asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). These materials are monitored and maintained following the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) guidelines and by using our management plan.

During this last school year the six month periodic surveillance was conducted in November 2016 and June 2017. Abatement and remediation activities occurred as a result of the periodic surveillance as well as renovations and construction activities. All abatement and remediation was handled by outside contractors properly licensed to work with ACBM. All records of abatement and remediation are included in the management plan.
