

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT
Education Consultant 2 - Parent Outreach for Birth - 5

Under the supervision of the Director of CERC, the Parent Outreach Coordinator for Birth - 5 is responsible for performing duties in the following areas:

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- Establishes and coordinates parent support groups and other parent outreach activities
- Will be expected to travel across the state organizing and coordinating activities and informational opportunities for parents
- Establishes a positive relationship with Tennessee Early Intervention Services (TEIS) and other agencies and groups serving deaf/hard of hearing families
- Assess needs of parents of deaf/hard of hearing children and coordinate resources to meet identified needs.

EVALUATION: Uses information from parent surveys and evaluations of programs to improve the outreach process, adapting and making adjustments as needed based on feedback. The Parent Outreach Coordinator for Birth - 5 position will be evaluated using the SMART Assessment.

LEADERSHIP: Takes a leadership role in improving education, and performing professional responsibilities.

COMMUNICATION: Uses correct grammar, written and oral communication is organized and clearly stated. Applicant must become proficient in sign language at the level established for this position within the Tennessee School for the Deaf Sign Communication Program as demonstrated by an appropriate assessment tool. Training will be provided.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Bachelor's Degree in Education
2. A minimum of three years' experience working with families or children who are deaf/hard of hearing.
3. Tennessee Driver's License and clean driving record is required.
4. As part of your duties, you may be required to mentor a TSD student in the TSD Work Based Learning Program.
5. Willingness to Travel

SALARY: \$4,295 - \$6,873 (depending on degree and years of service)

The applicant selected for this position will be fingerprinted and required to have a TBI/FBI background check. In addition, background checks will be conducted through the Tennessee Registry of Sexual Offenders, Tennessee Registry of Abusers, and the Tennessee Child Protective Services Background Check.
